INTRODUCTION ABOUT THE VILLAGE AND THE CENTRES

KASNA VILLAGE, GREATER NOIDA

KASNA is a popular village in Greater Noida, UP and has a population of around more than Fifty thousand people comprising of approximately Two thousand children. There are only around 5-8 organized /unorganized education centres to educate the children. However, the quality of education remains a question mark. Kasna is a village where most of the families have migrated from West Bengal, Bihar, Uttaranchal, Orissa etc. They live on rent in the jhuggis of Kasna. The basic occupation of the people are rickshaw pullers, vegetable sellers, labour working on daily wages, hawkers etc. Thus, with the support of Gautama Buddha Society, Niveda Foundation was able to identify a location, and mobilized and identified 50 non-school going children, and started the Early Learning Centre.

SECTOR-10, NOIDA

Sector – 10 mainly consists of Industries due to which the surrounding population is composed of labours, rickshaw pullers and daily wage workers. As a result, many small children are found as rag pickers and labours working on daily wages because of lack of awareness about education.

Therefore, Niveda Foundation along with Gautama Buddha Society came with an initiative to help the underprivileged children to get their identity by providing them education and better way of living. This is an initiative to mobilise the non-school going children and mainstream them to formal schooling.

SECTOR-17, NOIDA

Sec 17, JJ Colony is an area which is a core slum belt. Mostly people living here are migrants from Bihar, West Bengal and Orissa. Many small children were found as rag pickers because in this sector there is not any Government or Private or NGO Schools.

Therefore, Niveda Foundation along with Gautama Buddha Society came with an initiative to help underprivileged children to get their identity and start with their basic Education. This is an initiative to mobilise the non-school going children and mainstream them to formal schooling.

We also started role play teaching system. The role playing approach will help a student understand how the academic material will be relevant to his everyday tasks.

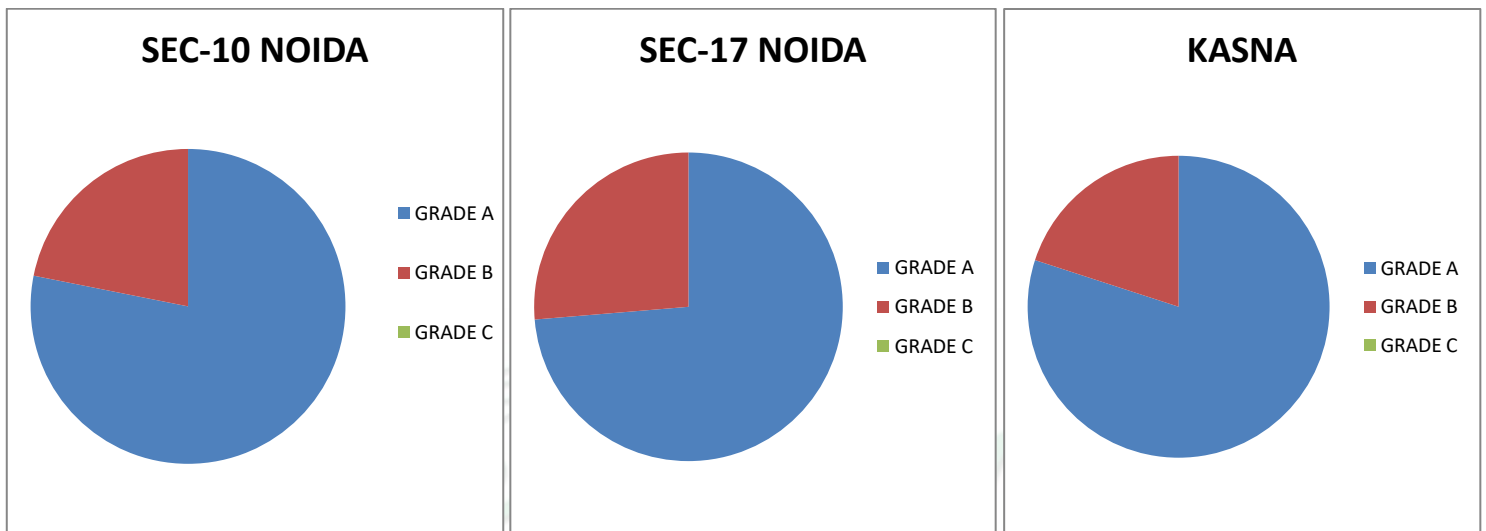
ASSESSMENT AND EXAMINATION OF THE STUDENTS

- **Type of assessment** – Half yearly assessment and Annual assessment
- **Pattern of assessment** - the examination is paper based which includes figures, pictures, fill in the blanks, true or false etc.
- **Grading system** - The examination is evaluated on grading criteria -
 - A- 80% and above
 - B- 60%-79%
 - C- 40%-59%
 - D- Below 40%
- **Frequency of assessment/examination**- 2 times a year
- **Total percentage of children attended the assessment** – 100%

Purpose of Assessment – The purpose of the assessment is to measure and evaluate the progress of the students. It is also a mechanism to check the efficiency of current teaching methodologies.
